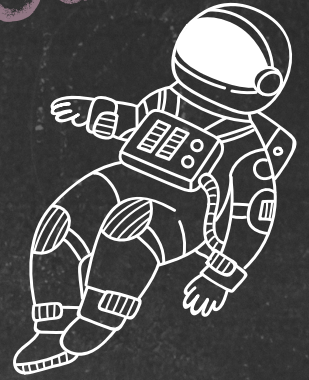

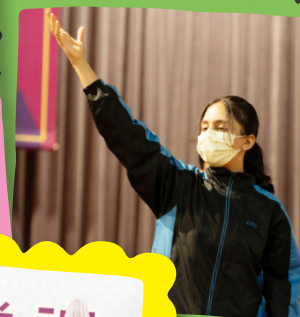

### 2A Hugo Liu

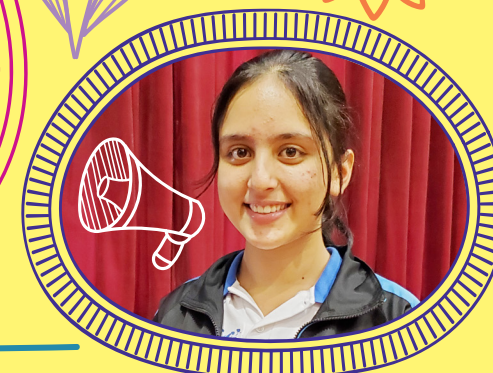
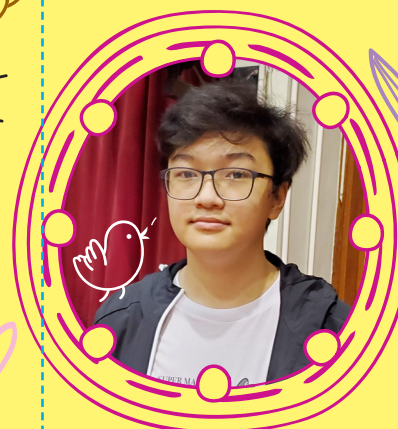
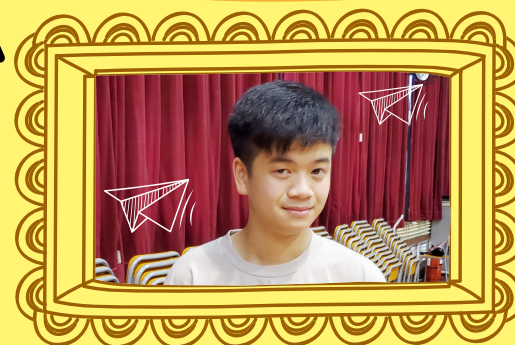
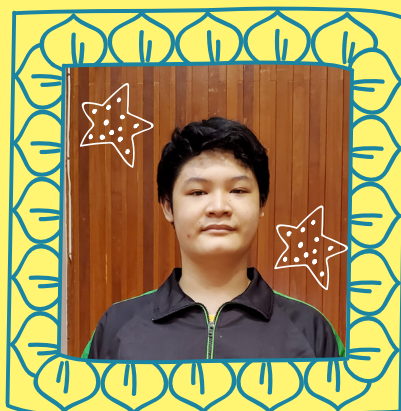
I was glad to join the drama performance this year. I have learnt the importance of teamwork. It has been a great experience and I wish I could join the performance again next year!




### 2A Bob Ng



